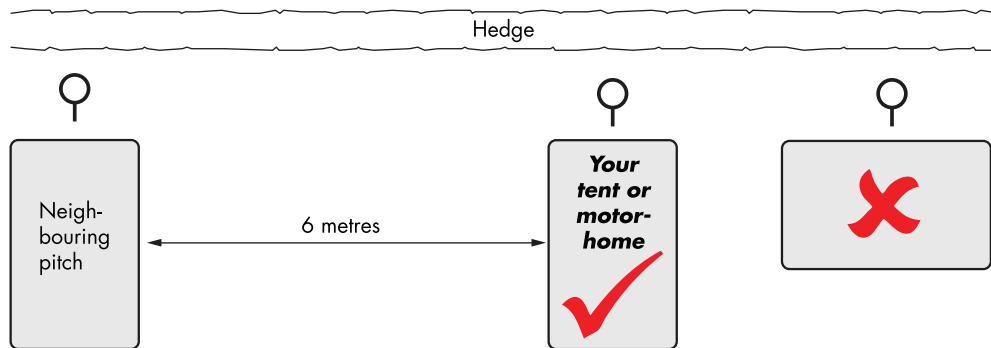

CAMPING FIELD



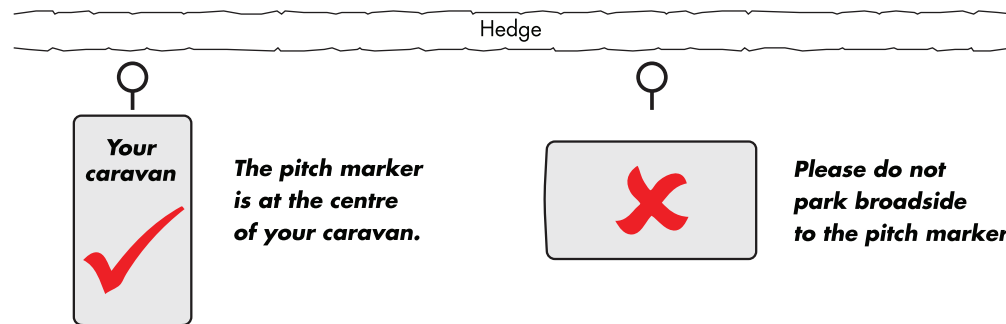
The pitch marker is the centre of your pitch, NOT the edge of your pitch.

Keep a 3-metre fire gap between your car and the neighbour's unit. Please ensure 6 metres between neighbouring pitches.

If you have a very large tent or motor home, please make sure the longest wall is facing into the field, not across the pitch.

Park cars alongside or in front of tents, but always across the slope.

CARAVAN FIELD



Please keep a 3-metre fire gap between your car and the neighbour's unit. On hardstanding pitches, make sure both the caravan and awning are on the hardstanding.

Pitches 6–14 & 50–53: Awnings should be to the east (entrance gate side); car parked alongside, or to the rear of, the caravan.

Pitches 38–42, 56: No awnings; the jockey wheel placed on the marker slab, car parked to the rear of the caravan.

Pitches 43–49, 55–58: Awnings should be to the east (entrance gate side); car parked alongside, or in front of, the caravan.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Pitches must be vacated by **11am** on day of departure. If you wish to stay longer, please check availability of your pitch as soon as possible.

Pitching Caravans, motorhomes and tents must pitch in positions as indicated above, or as advised by staff. Before pitching, ensure you have the correct pitch and spacing to avoid being asked to move. Camping tags, issued for Fields 2 & 3, should be clearly displayed.

Fires No camp fires. BBQs must be raised high enough so as to not burn the grass. BBQ stands are available from the office.

Gas/fumes Current legislation prohibits the covering of any gas appliance exhaust. Awnings must not enclose any exhausts, unless that exhaust is running on electricity. Do not put BBQ or similar in tent, awning or caravan.

Radios, stereos or other sound systems are permitted, though we request that visitors are considerate to others and keep the volume low. From 10pm to 8am the park must be quiet and voices must be lowered so they cannot be heard by the next-door unit. If you have any concerns regarding noise, please contact a member of staff.

Children Parents are to be responsible for their children at all times whilst on the park. An adult should accompany children under 7 years to the toilet and under 11 years to the showers. Please do not give small children the gate/door code.

Vehicles and bicycles All vehicles must register at the office. The Park speed limit is 10mph, 5mph over bumps. Cars must park across the slope. For safety, bicycles and scooters are not allowed on communal tarmac areas near toilet blocks, the Park entrance or road to the office. No cycling between dusk and dawn (unless part of a legitimate journey where the bicycle has lights). No skateboards.

Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times whilst on the park and exercised in the designated dog-walk area, or off the park. Please do not leave dogs unattended. Owners must remove any 'accidents' on park grounds and deposit in the dog bin or refuse bins. We regret that dogs are not permitted in the dog-free camping area in Field 3 (see map overleaf).

No smoking All buildings on the Park, hire tents and hired static caravans are smoke-free. Please do not smoke within 10 metres of building entrances.

Recycling Please recycle your glass, paper, tins, cardboard and plastic in the designated recycling bins. Food bins are available in the dish-wash rooms. Place all other refuse in skip bins. Do not leave rubbish outside your tent/caravan – it makes a quick and messy meal for seagulls, badgers and foxes. Please put your food in suitable sealable containers.

Waste disposal Do not put face/cleaning wipes in the chemical waste (this includes in your cassette) – these wipes do not degrade and block our drains. Chemical/grey waste facilities are shown on map overleaf. Please flush/rinse after using facility.

Kites and drones Please do not fly kites or drones on the site. Gusts of wind can cause kites to suddenly swoop down and damage tents, motorhomes, caravans and buildings.

Complaints Should you experience any problems with any equipment/park facilities, or have any queries during your stay, our staff will be pleased to be of assistance. Out of hours, the emergency telephone number, displayed in the office window, can be used to contact the owner or warden using your own mobile phone. The emergency telephone, location shown on the map overleaf, can be used to contact emergency services and the site owner.
